School Garden Farm Stands Open late June - early August

The School Garden Farm Stands sell fresh produce grown by Calypso staff & youth participating in Calypso's summer programs hosted at the school gardens including the EATinG Program and LEAF Camps.

EATinG (Engaging Alaskan Teens in Gardening) is a free summer program for youth ages 11-16. Student gardeners are empowered to grow their own food, and gain business and leadership skills by selling their veggies at their weekly farm stand!

LEAF (Learning Ecology and Alaskan Farming) Camps take place at each of our School Gardens and engage youth campers in a wide range of activities, including cooking and tasting garden veggies, exploring art and science in the garden, and much more!
